- 1 267 Bingley Road BD18 4DW**
We are botanical designers and over the past few years we have been transforming our backyard car park into a cutting garden and naturalistic space. Our botanical pop-up shop provides small garden inspiration, plants, fresh flowers, dried bouquets, and Japanese tools.
- 2 25 Dallam Avenue BD18 4PA**
Small sunny patio garden with raised beds, seating areas, greenhouse and shed, two years in the making. Contains trees, perennials, annuals, fruit and vegetables.
- 3 73 Albert Road BD18 4NS**
Raised garden area, loosely planted with shrubs, leads to an oblong sunken garden, edged with large pots, offering a courtyard effect.
- 4 51 Albert Road BD18 4NS**
Il Pirata Pizzata's Disco Pizza Party. Saltaire locals serving the tastiest Neo-Neapolitan pizzas this side of Naples. For one weekend only, find us at our home address instead of Tambourine coffee.
- 5 21 Albert Road BD18 4NR**
A secluded garden with mature shrubs and trees created from scratch a decade ago. Plus a pop up shop selling cards, notebooks, coasters, T shirts and other handmade and hand printed items.
- 6 19 Titus Street BD18 4LT**
Discover and purchase lovingly handmade home decor created using jesmonite, an eco-friendly, toxic-free resin that gives a gorgeous smooth stone effect.
- 7 24 Mary Street BD18 4PQ**
A pretty garden with bee-loving flowers creating a haven for relaxation and enjoyment. Interesting features include a bespoke bench, table and vertical wood planter.
- 8 21 Helen Street BD18 4PH**
Vintage themed pop-up selling toys, books (for adults and children), bric-a-brac, clothes, jewellery, pictures and picture frames. Individual items in china and wood.
- 9 22 Helen Street BD18 4PH**
Children's mini treasure hunt, plants for sale (house and garden plants)
- 10 38 Helen Street BD18 4PH**
A collection of prints and jewellery from three artists from Bradford and a DJ playing music. We will be showing jewellery designed by talented artists with disabilities from the centre at Northcliffe Environmental Enterprises team in Northcliffe Park.

- 11 12 Caroline Street BD18 4QA**
The original wash house with baths and facilities for washing clothes opened in 1863. The building has been demolished and replaced by a community garden, jointly maintained by Veg on the Edge and community volunteers.
- 12 Upper Ada Street: Yard Fest**
The popular acoustic music, food and drink mini-Festival returns this year with drinks from Cap and Collar and food from Edward Street Bakery.
- 13 48 George Street BD18 4PL**
Small front garden densely planted with species roses, perennials and vegetables in pots. Backyard with limited sun. Trellis provides screening and movable pots create seasonal focus.
- 14 3 Katherine Street BD18 4LZ**
Shaded courtyard garden with roses plus mixed and raised beds on the alley.
- 15 37 Dove Street BD18 3EY**
An edible, wildlife friendly garden in a pocket-sized back yard! Perennial edibles of all kinds. Selection of pieces made by John Egerton the potter. OPEN SUNDAY only.
- 16 5 Rhodes Street BD18 3JJ**
Ginny's low carb, vegan and non-dairy food and drink. Food for sale will include savoury low carb and low sugar pies, vegetable dips, non-dairy and vegan cakes. Recipe flyers to take away. Free teas and coffee with oat milk from 11.00 to 12.00.
