8 3, Katherine Street BD18 4LZ: Shaded courtyard garden with roses, plus mixed and raised beds in the alley. See also the best communally planted snicket in Saltaire!

9 37, Dove Street BD18 3EY: Back yard 'larder garden' with lots of pollinators and plants. Pottery by John Egerton and plants for sale.

10 6, George Street: BD18 3EZ: A summer garden collaboration. FoundWare: carefully sourced objects for thoughtfully designed interiors plus Silly Wednesday: planet friendly, size inclusive, fun clothing made in Saltaire.

11 Upper Ada Street: Yard Fest. Don't miss this popular acoustic music, food and drink mini-Festival with drinks from Cap and Collar and food from Edward Street Bakery.

12 19, Titus Street BD18 4LT: Discover and purchase lovingly handmade home decor created using Jesmonite, an eco-friendly, non-toxic resin that gives a gorgeous smooth stone effect.

13 22, Helen Street BD18 4PH: Our 'garden' and pop up shop will be selling an eclectic mix of vintage items, upcycled items and gorgeous plants (for home and garden).

14 24, Mary Street BD18 4PQ: A haven for relaxation and enjoyment. See the imaginative use of found objects and bespoke items made for the garden.

15 12, Caroline Street BD18 4QA: The original wash house with baths and facilities for washing clothes opened in 1863. The building has been demolished and replaced by a community garden, jointly maintained by Veg on the Edge and community volunteers.

16 48, George Street BD18 4PL: Plants, many fragrant, flower in all months except November. Shade-tolerant plants thrive in the back yard with vegetables at the front. Clematis Armandii provides an evergreen screen.

17 Exhibition Road BD18 3JW: Shipley College Garden developed by Horticulture staff and students since 2015 when the Jonathan Silver building opened.

18 8, Rhodes Street BD18 3JJ: Join us for a refreshing gin cocktail (or two) between noon and 17.00. Whether you're a gin lover or not, we'll find something to suit your taste buds.

19 47, Rhodes Street BD18 3JJ: Handmade lino prints, original artwork and digital prints featuring Saltaire and local scenes. Fresh homemade cakes also available.

20 202 Saltaire Road BD18 3JF: Salts Works/ People Powered Press. Visit the People Powered Press Poetry and Print Garden featuring artworks written and handprinted by local people and by the People Powered Press team. Artworks for sale.

21 1, Salts Mews, Saltaire Road BD18 3AX: Prints, cards and zines for sale featuring the owner's illustrations in this permaculture-inspired garden. Kitchen pop-up if it is raining. Permaculture education at ktshepherdpermaculture.com
